### WHAT DO WE NEED?

It is true that we have accomplished part of our goal: 672 names on the 14 Walls Of Honor, the KIA Walls, the Emblem Wall, POW/MIA Wall, Index, and the Contributor Wall of Honor. After considerable expenditures and the contribution of a lot of labor, materials, equipment use, and expertise we find ourselves at this point today. The following is a list of some of the tasks necessary to make it an attractive place we can all be proud of:

### PRIORITY

Landscaping Phase I was completed before the 2007 Memorial Day Program. The Carroll County Master Gardeners, the Spade and Trowel Garden Club, Jim Carnes Landscaping, and James Hembree –UWG Arboretum, lead this effort.

Now we need to proceed with Phase II which covers the vacant lot next to the park. Architect Sandra Verling has drawn a suggested plan with the lay out of the entire space. The Veterans Committee approved the out line and will consider each feature as we raise the money to build it.

The fountain is the nearest item to the existing park and that is the one we are trying to raise funds to build next. The cost will be \$40,800 for the Fountain. It will be constructed with material to match the existing Park. There will be walkways slopping down hill just a little bit and around the Fountain. It will be accessible to older citizens and any handicapped veterans or visitors.

We are happy to tell you that the Georgia Master Gardener Association approved our grant request for the soil, plants and flowers that will be needed around the fountain when it is completed. Thank you Georgia Master Gardener Association!

The UWG Arboretum has promised us 15 trees to be planted on or near the 2008 Arbor Day. We plan to have a program during this planting event at the Park.
